SECURITY SPOTLIGHT: The Importance of Laptop Encryption

Encryption is the coding of information – often for the purpose of making the data unreadable by an unauthorized user. The only way to access encrypted data is with a password and decryption key. Data encryption is a fairly straightforward and transparent process. We suggest that every mobile device be encrypted as a simple, yet highly effective measure of network security.

Why Encrypt My Laptop?

If your laptop is lost or stolen, you aren't just out an expensive device. Whoever has your device has access to all your information – even if it's password protected. An attacker can remove the hard drive, put it into another computer, and access your data - no password required.

If the culprit gains access, they have your personal information and your company's private data. Furthermore, it's likely that they can break into your email. With access to email, they can hack any other accounts associated with it.

Bitlocker Encryption

Bitlocker is an encryption system that comes with Windows 10 Pro. It turns all your computer's data into jumbled codes. The codes are only decipherable with the decryption key. So, even if a criminal gets your device, they can't access your data without the encryption or login password.

Login & Encryption Passwords

When creating a password, it's important to make it something that isn't easily guessable. When we setup the encryption password - which is a long random key that is seperate from your login password, we save this within our documentation. Just like any company computer - please make sure company data is saved on the company network drives to ensure that it's backed up!

Should I Remove Local Admin Rights?

3CX has released a useful new feature – voicemail transcription to email. Many customers already use the voicemail to email feature which sends the recorded voicemails to their inboxes. Now, 3CX has come together with Google Speech services to transcribe voicemails and deliver the text to your inbox along with the sound files.

Transcription allows you to check voicemails quicker than ever. Simply skim through text rather than listen to an entire message.

Transcription services are free for up to 60 minutes of VM per month, and \$0.006 per 15 seconds thereafter. To set up VM transcription, email: support@glassen.net




Photo: Transcription and sound file of VM sent to email
